Westtown Wins Third Championship in the Past Four Years

Before a packed, rocking house at Haverford College on Friday night, February 13th, #1 seed Westtown defeated #3 seed Germantown by a score of 52-44. The Moose used their significant height advantage and a tenacious defense to best the scrappy Tigers. 6'11" Mohamed Bamba led the winners with 13 points (4 dunks), 8 rebounds and 7 blocked shots. Jair Bolden had 15 points (2 threes), all but one of those in the first half. Ray Leon led a trio of Tigers in double figures with a game high 16 points. Michael Buckmire added 14 points (12 in the second half) and Andrew Aldridge dropped 10 in amongst the trees. After the first quarter ended with a score of 8-8, Westtown pulled away with a 15-5 second quarter advantage paced by stifling defense, Bamba's swats and 7 points from Bolden. The Tigers did not quit, though. After 'town scored the first 5 points after intermission to stretch their lead to 28-13, GFS won the rest of third period 13-5 behind Leon and Buckmire. In the end, though, Westtown's height proved to be too much and they won the fourth quarter 19-18 to claim their fourth boys' hoops title overall.

In one semifinal on Tuesday, February 10th Westtown topped ANC 67-48. The hosts expanded on a 16-8 first quarter advantage with a 21-6 surge in the second period. The Moose used a balanced scoring attack with five players in double figures led by Bolden with 15 points. Bamba hit for 13, Jonathan Kasibabu 12 and Edvanus Rupkus and Najja Hunter each tallied 10. Vince Jackson with 17 points (5 threes) took game scoring honors for the Lions, while Carnel Harley chipped in with 12 points. In the other semifinal Germantown upset #2 seed Friends' Central 61-52. The Tigers reversed a 19-point loss to the Phoenix just a week earlier when they fell behind 22-5 after one quarter. This time the two teams battled on even terms through three + periods before the Tigers stretched the lead and then closed the deal at the foul line, hitting 11 of 13 free throws in the final period. Both teams were hot from the charity stripe with Germantown sinking 14 of 17 and Friends' Central 18 of 20 attempts. As much as anything, the Tigers' work on the defensive end of the floor was responsible for the win. Offensively Germantown was led by Leon with 28 points (5 threes). Buckmire added 12 points and Jalil Pines-Elliott contributed 10 points. De'Andre Hunter led all scorers with 33 points (23 of the Phoenix's 33 in the second half). Chuck Champion added 12 points, as one of only 3 players to score for the hosts.

In the Quaker Cup final host Moorestown needed overtime to top Abington 44-40. The Foxes trailed most of the way before Jordan White hit a trey to tie the score 10 seconds before the end of regulation. Joe Biedeman paced the winners with 11 points (7-7 from the foul line) and White contributed 10 points. Austin Levin and Sam Levy each tallied 11 points for the 'roos.

In the semifinals on Tuesday, February 10th Moorestown beat Friends Select 69-16, while Abington edged George School 45-44. At Moorestown the hosts jumped out to a 20-3 first quarter advantage and never looked back. Beideman paced the Foxes with 18 points while Noah Magaziner added a season-high 13. The Falcons, playing without their leading scorer, Andrew Chachoute, were led by Jacob Taranta with 9 points all on threes. At Abington the 'roos needed a jumper by Jordan Baker with 1.5 seconds remaining in regulation to edge the Cougars. Abington also playing without it's leading scorer, Yohn Hall, was led by Jake Stark with 13 and Baker with 12. Together they scored 14 of Abington's 17 fourth quarter points. The visitors were led by Chris Gilbert with 12 points and Austin Murphy with 11.

Westtown Clinches First Place, FCS Grabs Second

In a showdown between the two unbeaten league leaders, Westtown handily defeated host Friends' Central 66-46 on Friday, January 30th. The visitors jumped out to a 20-4 first-quarter advantage and held on as the final three periods yielded even scoring. The Moose were paced by Jonathan Kasibabu with 22 points. Najjia Hunter added 12 points and Jair Bolden tallied 11 for the winners. Chuck Champion netted 13 points for the Phoenix while De'Andre Hunter and Jonathan Lawton each scored 12. Also on the 30th, Shipley defeated visiting ANC 57-47 while host Germantown topped Friends Select 74-27 and visiting Moorestown beat Abington 57-45. At Shipley, the Gators found themselves trailing 28-17 at the half and 39-36 after three periods before exploding for a 21-8 fourth quarter surge to beat the Lions. Sam Sessoms led the winners with 18 points (12 in the fourth quarter). Kiyon Hardy added 14 points and Arville Jones 12 to the winning cause. Marcus Little paced the visitors with 12 points and Carnel Harley chipped in with 11. The two teams will meet again at Shipley on 2/6 in the 4/5 game. At Germantown, the hosts jumped out to a 22-4 first quarter advantage, but the Falcons wouldn't quit, winning the second period 17-15. The Tigers had their way in the second half, holding the visitors to just 6 points after the intermission. Andrew Aldridge led the winners with 26 points while Ray Leon netted 22. Brendan Durst and Andrew Chachoute each tallied 11 points for Select. The final game on the 30th saw Moorestown top Abington for the first time in 23 years (a 43-40 overtime win on January 31st 1992). The Foxes opened up a 12-7 lead after one period but trailed at the half 27-25. The score was tied at 39 after three periods, and again at 45-45 before Moorestown scored the final 12 points to end the contest. Joe Biedeman led the winners with 15

points, followed closely by John Nutaitis and Jordan White each with 14. Sam Levy had 13 and Jordan Baker 11 to lead the 'roos.

On Saturday, January 31st Abington hosted Friends Select in a makeup game and won 66-45. The 'roos, who trailed 10-6 after one quarter, used a 24-11 second quarter advantage to erase the deficit and then pulled away from the Falcons after intermission. Levy again paced the winners with 24 points (12 in the final period). Baker netted 16 and Jared Smith 10 for Abington. Chachoute and Durst again shared the scoring lead for Select with 18 points each.

Three games were played on Tuesday, February 3. In a battle for second place, Friends' Central came out victorious at Germantown by a score of 66-47. Host ANC topped Abington 61-35 and Shipley beat host Friends Select 75-18. On February 4th Westtown finished their regular season undefeated with a 70-37 road win over Moorestown. At Germantown, the Phoenix came out on fire and did to the Tigers what the Moose had done to them a few days earlier. The visitors jumped out to a 22-5 lead after one quarter and the Tigers could never get back in the game after that. Hunter paced the winners with 22 points, 11 boards and 4 blocks, while Lawton added 21 and guarded Tigers star Leon all game. Champion added 18 for the visitors. Leon had 14, Jalil Pines-Elliott had 13 and Aldridge added 12 for GFS. The two teams will meet again in a semifinal contest at FCS on Tuesday, February 10. ANC pulled away from a 6-point halftime advantage with a 22-6 third quarter on the way to their win over Abington. Little again paced the Lions with 20 points, while Harley and Jackson each chipped in with 10. Jake Stark paced the 'roos with 11 points. At Friends Select, Shipley opened up a large first-quarter advantage and was never challenged. Kevin Zwolak led 11 Gators in the scoring column with 15 points and Sebastian Pepper added 11. Matthew Chin paced the Falcons with 7 points.

At Moorestown on 2/4 Westtown had huge first and third quarters to assure their 8th league win of the season. Kasibabu again led the scoring parade with 19 points and Bamba contributed 17. Beideman led the Foxes with 17 points and CJ Eni added 10. Westtown awaits the winner of the 4/5 playin game on Friday, February 6th between ANC and Shipley.

The final makeup game was played on Thursday, February 5th. Shipley visited Moorestown and took home an 80-54 win, clinching 4th place in the regular season. The Gators led by only 4 points after

the first quarter, but used a 26-7 advantage in the second period to pull away from the hosts. Quamier Johnson exploded for 30 points to pace the winners. Sessoms added 15 and Jones 12. White topped the Foxes' scoring column with 18 points, while Elijah O'Neal added 12 and Biedeman 11.

The 4/5 play-in game pitted host Shipley against ANC. The Lions led most of the way by between 5 and 9 points, before the Gators closed at the end, but the visitors prevailed 46-43 to earn a visit to # 1 seed Westtown in the semifinals. Harley paced the winners with 20 points and Matthue Cotton added 10 to the winning cause. Jones led the hosts with 13 points, while Hardy added 11 and Johnson 10.

Friends' Central - Westtown Showdown Upcoming

Four games were played on Friday, January 23rd. Westtown beat host Shipley 62-44. Abington gained its first league win on the road at George School, 47-42. Host Moorestown lost to Friends' Central 71-49. The final game saw host Germantown nip ANC 55-54 in a thriller. At Shipley, the Moose used a 33-11 advantage over the middle two periods to pull away from the Gators. Jair Bolden with 18 points (4 threes) and Mohamed Bamba with 14 paced the winners. Quamier Johnson took game scoring honors with 20 points for the hosts. Yohn Hall paced Abington with 21 points in Coach Chadwin's 601st career win. Shadimere Coles paced the Cougars with 17 points. Friends' Central jumped out to a 22-9 lead after the first quarter and never looked back. De'Andre Hunter led the Phoenix with 26 points (10-15 from the charity stripe), while Chuck Champion added 19 and Jonathan Lawton chipped in with 15. Joe Biedeman paced the Foxes with 20 points and Jordan White added 15. At Germantown the Tigers found themselves trailing by 15 points (42-27) midway through the third quarter before they chipped away at the margin to create a super exciting finish to the contest. Ray Leon gave the Tigers their first lead of the game, 53-52 with 7 seconds left on a basket and a free throw. The Lions' Vince Jackson was fouled in the backcourt on the ensuing play and calmly sank both ends of a 1 and 1 to put the visitors back in front 54-53. Leon was then fouled immediately as the ball was inbounded to him and he drained both free throws in a double bonus situation with 4.3 seconds on the clock to clinch the hosts' first win over ANC since 2004. Leon led all scorers with 29 points (22 in the second half including 12 for 13 from the line). Jackson paced the Lions with 17 points, while Carnel Harley added 15.

Three postponed games were played on Wednesday, January 28th. Visiting Shipley topped Abington 58-44. Host Friends' Central beat George School 66-40. Westtown topped visiting ANC 51-34. At Abington, the Gators used a 16-7 third quarter run to stretch a 7-point halftime advantage. Johnson again led all scorers with 20 points, while Kyon Hardy added 11 and Sam Sessoms chipped in with 10 for the winners. Hall paced the 'roos with 14 points while Jordan Baker and Sam Levy each netted 11. Friends' Central stayed unbeaten in the league as they won every quarter in their game with George School. The Phoenix placed four players in double figures, led by Lawton with 18. Champion scored 16, Hunter 15 and Antone Walker 12. Jibri Loving led the Cougars with 12 points.
