

Penn Charter seizes Inter-Ac track crown

Sixty-two turned out to be a lucky number for Penn Charter at the 116th Inter-Ac League track and field championships yesterday.

The Quakers won the final event on their home track — the 4x400-meter relay — and won their 62d title with 62 points.

Penn Charter trailed Chestnut Hill Academy by a point, 57-56, going into the relay, but Will Darrah put the Quakers into the lead going into the anchor leg and they edged the Hillers to win by six-tenths of a second with a time of 3 minutes, 32.72 seconds and the team title by a point.

Chestnut Hill's Pete Harris won the George Anderson Award for scoring the most individual points with 18. He won the 100-meter dash in 10.92 seconds, the 200-meter dash in 22.71 seconds, and the 400-meter dash in 51.15 seconds.

Lex Mercado was a double-winner for Penn Charter. He took the 1,600-meter run in 4:30.84 and the 3,200-meter run in 9:55.18.

onship meet at Villa Maria.

The Quakers won the boys' championship and the overall league title with 98½ points while the girls did the same with 85½ points.

Dan Mays and Ray Bobrownicki won four individual events for Westtown. Mays won the shot put (41-2), the discus (130-2), the javelin (146-1) and the pole vault (11-0).

Bobrownicki set a meet record in the high jump with a leap of 6 feet, 8 inches, breaking his own mark set last year of 6-6. He also won the long jump (20-6), the triple jump (41-10½), and the 110-meter hurdles (15.2 seconds).

In the girls' meet, the Quakers won seven of 17 events, including the pole vault, in which Anna Leinberger broke her meet record of 7-3 set last year when she crossed the bar at 8-0.

George School's Betty Rogers was the only multiple winner, taking the long jump (15-1¼), triple jump (33-3) and shot put (31-9).
