## MOORESTOWN UNDEFEATED AFTER THIRD WEEK OF PLAY

Moorestown, which has never finished higher than fourth place in 18 previous years of league play, is sitting atop the standings with about 60% of the season complete. The Foxes are 4-0, with George School, Friends' Central, ANC and Abington close behind. Here are summaries of the first 17 League games.

Tuesday 9/21 Germantown traveled to Westtown to open FSL play for the year and outplayed the hosts, but lost 2-1 on two goals by Ian Dana. Fiver Soraruf assisted on the first tally. Junior Ben Shell scored for the Tigers.

Friday 9/24 Host ANC scored first, but could not hold the lead in a 2-1 loss to Abington. Senior Mark Geanuleas netted a 20<sup>th</sup> minute penalty kick to open the scoring for the Lions, but senior Dan Dratch evened the score just two minutes later for the 'roos. Freshman Chris Hood tallied the game-winner in the 50<sup>th</sup> minute.

Friday 9/24 Host Friends' Central blanked Friends Select 2-0. Junior Ryan Tozer netted a first-half goal, while classmate Erich Vadino tallied with 10 minutes left in the game. Freshman Warren Richards assisted on both goals. Senior Zach Driscoll was in goal for the shutout.

Friday 9/24 Visiting George School used a 23<sup>rd</sup> minute unassisted goal by sophomore Masayuki Nishimoto to top Germantown 1-0. Junior Seth Shipon made 5 saves for the shutout.

Friday 9/24 Senior Jackiem Wright scored his second goal of the game three minutes into the second overtime period to carry visiting Moorestown to a 2-1 decision over Westtown. Kenny Ro opened the scoring for the hosts in the 34<sup>th</sup> minute, assisted by Ian Dana. Wright forced overtime with a 74<sup>th</sup> minute tally, assisted by Adam Briggs.

Tuesday 9/28 Visiting ANC took an early lead and was never caught at Westtown. Mark Geanuleas scored for the Lions in the 8<sup>th</sup> and 46<sup>th</sup> minutes, assisted by

Anders Hyatt and Joseph Herr. The hosts pulled close on a 62<sup>nd</sup> minute header by Fiver Soraruf, but Hyatt netted a penalty kick in the 68<sup>th</sup> minute to finalize the score at 3-1.

Friday 10/1 Moorestown handed visiting ANC its first loss of the season, 3-0. The Foxes tallied three times in the first half and held on for the shutout. A 6<sup>th</sup> minute direct kick by Seth Hasbrouck, a 17<sup>th</sup> minute penalty kick by Matt Cutler and a 24<sup>th</sup> minute header by Jackiem Wright off a cross from Eric Lundin provided all the offense and Matt Stevens preserved the shutout in goal for the hosts.

Friday 10/1 Host George School overwhelmed Friends Select 5-0. The Cougars tallied twice in the first half (seniors Nick Kerr and Pete Frazier) and three times in the second period (junior Shannon Varney, senior Marc Parish, and sophomore Masayuki Nishimoto). Parish, along with classmates John Robinson and Chad Brophy and junior Curt Tanner supplied assists. Junior Seth Shipon was in goal for the shutout.

Friday 10/1 Visiting Germantown lost its third straight 1-goal game, 2-1 to Friends' Central. After a scoreless first half, the Phoenix opened the scoring on a 49<sup>th</sup> minute goal by Bernard Singer, assisted by Ryan Tozer. The Tigers even the score just three minutes later on a goal by senior Jesse Silverstein off a corner kick by senior Dan Schwartzman. The hosts took the win on a 78<sup>th</sup> minute tally by Erich Vadino with an assist to Warren Richards.

Friday 10/1 Host Abington beat Westtown 3-1. Senior Dan Dratch opened the scoring for the 'roos in the 15<sup>th</sup> minute with an assist from classmate Dan Kollros. Fiver Soraruf evened it up for the visitors just five minutes later with an unassisted goal. Dratch tallied again in the 50<sup>th</sup> minute with an assist from junior Colin Ellis and freshman Chris Hood closed out the scoring in the 70<sup>th</sup> minute with an assist from senior Mike Ellis.

Tuesday 10/5 Host George School made two first half goals by sophomore Masayuki Nishimoto stand up for a 2-0 blanking of previously unbeaten Friends' Central. Senior Marc Parish assisted on the 9<sup>th</sup> minute goal, while the 24<sup>th</sup> minute tally was a solo effort. Junior Seth Shipon made three saves to preserve the shutout.

Tuesday 10/5 Host ANC scored three breakaway goals to overwhelm Germantown 4-1. The Tigers scored first on a 15<sup>th</sup> minute shot by junior Elan Gepner, but the Lions evened it up just 6 minutes later on a goal by Drew Synnestvedt. The winners scored three times in the second half to put the game away. Mark Geanuleas tallied in the 50<sup>th</sup> minute, Joseph Herr in the 57<sup>th</sup> and Matthew Keith in the 68<sup>th</sup> minute.

Tony Cinkutis assisted with long through balls on the first and third of those goals, while Jason Hyatt assisted Herr.

Tuesday 10/5 Visiting Moorestown handed Abington its first league loss 2-1 in a mud bowl. The Foxes tallied first on a 12<sup>th</sup> minute header by senior Evan Sauer with an assist from classmate Jerry Appleton. The 'roos evened the score on a 30<sup>th</sup> minute goal by senior Dan Dratch with an assist from classmate Seth Taft. Appleton put in the game-winner in the 45<sup>th</sup> minute on a solo effort.

Tuesday 10/5 Visiting Westtown scored two goals in overtime (one in each period) to top Friends Select 4-2. Select's goals came in the 16<sup>th</sup> minute from Gerry Bissinger on a head ball and in the 72<sup>nd</sup> minute by Max Pinsky to send the game into overtime. Falcon goalie Steve Cox made a great final minute save to preserve the need for overtime. Westtown's goal scorers were unreported as of press time.

Thursday 10/7 Host Moorestown used three first-half goals on the way to a 4-0 defeat of Friends Select and upped their league record to 4-0. Adam Briggs tallied in the 11<sup>th</sup> minute, Mick Brick in the 26<sup>th</sup> (both unassisted) and Jerry Appleton scored in the 39<sup>th</sup> minute with an assist from Matt McMahon. Appleton closed out the scoring on a solo effort in the 72<sup>nd</sup> minute. Matt Stevens had 5 saves in goal for the shutout.

Friday 10/8 Visiting ANC handed George School its first league defeat 1-0 on a 46<sup>th</sup> minute tally by Mark Geanuleas, assisted by Joseph Herr. Jared Alden recorded 5 saves on the way to the shutout.

Friday 10/8 Visiting Friends' Central remained in the thick of the playoff race with a 1-0 win at Westtown. A 20<sup>th</sup> minute goal by sophomore Ben Schwartz with an assist from freshman Warren Richards was all the scoring in the game. Senior Zach Driscoll tended for the shutout for the Phoenix.

## MOORESTOWN UNDEFEATED AFTER THIRD WEEK OF PLAY

On Tuesday, October 12<sup>th</sup> host Abington topped George School 3-1 with all the goals coming in the first half. George opened the scoring in the 14<sup>th</sup> minute on a goal by junior Curt Tanner assisted by junior Masayuki Nishimoto. The 'roos tied it up ten minutes later on a tally by senior Dan Dratch assisted by freshman Stewart Rodes. Dratch corner kicks resulted in the final two goals in the last 10 minutes of the half, the first knocked in by junior Colin Ellis and the second by freshman Chris Hood. Excellent goal keeping by junior Tom Arnold preserved the win for the home team.

On Wednesday, October 13<sup>th</sup> visiting Germantown gained its first win of the season with a 2-0 blanking of Friends Select. Senior Dan Schwartzman opened the scoring in the 34<sup>th</sup> minute with an assist from sophomore Dan Hershberg. Junior Elan Gepner headed in a Schwartzman cross in the 56<sup>th</sup> minute to give the Tigers some breathing room. Sophomore Zach Perch made 5 saves for the shutout.

On Friday, October 15<sup>th</sup> George School regained it's winning ways with a 4-0 blanking of visiting Westtown. Nishimoto opened the scoring in just the 2<sup>nd</sup> minute of play with an assist from Tanner. Senior Marc Parish netted the second goal on a direct kick in the 32<sup>nd</sup> minute. Tanner scored the third goal with an assist from Parish in the 45<sup>th</sup> minute and senior Nick Kerr finished the scoring in the 51<sup>st</sup> minute with an assist from sophomore Josh Mandell. Junior Seth Shipon made seven saves to preserve the shutout.

Also on 10/15 host ANC beat Friends' Central 3-0, with all of the goals being scored in overtime. In the 87<sup>th</sup> minute of play senior Anders Hyatt broke the ice with a 35 yarder on a direct kick. Juniors Mark Geanuleas and Drew Synnnevstedt added goals in the second overtime period with sophomore Brandon Asplundh assisting on the first of them.

On Saturday, October 16<sup>th</sup>, with a large crowd of supporters from both schools looking on, host Germantown handed Moorestown its first FSL defeat of the year, 1-0. Germantown had the better of the first-half play in an intense game, but it wasn't until early in the second half that Schwartzman was able to nudge in a ball off a goal-mouth scramble. The Tigers held on through the final 30 minutes, with both sides having some good chances, to record their second consecutive league shutout with Perch in goal.

## MOORESTOWN FINISHES FIRST; PLAYOFF PAIRINGS SET

On Friday, October 22<sup>nd</sup> Moorestown scored a thrilling 2-1 overtime win against George School to clinch 1<sup>st</sup> place in the regular season for the first time ever. Senior Jerry Appleton scored unassisted for the Foxes in the 34<sup>th</sup> minute. The Cougars tied it up on a 78<sup>th</sup> minute goal from junior Jay Henriques assisted by sophomore Josh Mandell. The score remained knotted until senior Jackiem Wright volleyed in a cross from Matt McMahon with just three minutes remaining in the second OT. Also on the 22<sup>nd</sup> Abington clinched second place and knocked Friends' Central out of the playoffs with a 1-0 win on the road. Senior Seth Taft scored for the 'roos in the first half with an assist from freshman Stewart Rodes. Senior Tom Arnold made 8 saves for the shutout. The final Friday game saw host ANC blank Friends Select 6-0. Seniors Glen Herder and Adam Andrews each had two goals for the Lions, while classmate Anders Hyatt and sophomore Lane Genzlinger added single tallies. Five different players added assists. Jared Alden had nine saves for the shutout.

The final regular season game was played on Tuesday, October 26<sup>th</sup> and saw Germantown and Abington play to a 1-1 tie. Junior Rob Lane scored early in the second half with an assist from senior Dan Schwartzman. Jody McVeigh-Schultz evened the score with just five minutes left in regulation. Arnold preserved the tie with a brilliant full out save in overtime on an Elan Gepner header which was ticketed for the upper 90.

Playoff pairings for Saturday, October 30<sup>th</sup> are: Moorestown hosting George in a rematch of last week's classic, and Abington hosting ANC, with the 'roos having won the regular season match up 2-1 in Bryn Athyn.

## GEORGE SCHOOL REPEATS; ALL PLAYOFF GAMES CLOSE

George School rode a 33<sup>rd</sup> minute goal by junior Curt Tanner and a strong performance by classmate Seth Shipon in goal to a 1-0 championship win on Wednesday, November 3<sup>rd</sup> at Abington Friends. The Cougars withstood strong second half pressure from the host 'roos to hold on for their second consecutive title and their 10<sup>th</sup> in the past fourteen years. Play in the first half was quite even, although it looked like the visitors would take the early lead when junior Masayuki Nishimoto had a breakaway in the 5<sup>th</sup> minute, but waited too long to get just the right angle and allowed junior keeper Tom Arnold to regain his position and make the save. Both teams had good chances and both keepers were up to the task until George was given a direct from about 30 yards out on the left wing. Senior Marc Parrish hit a solid ball to the far post where Tanner was one of three Cougars waiting to knock it home. Abington increased the pressure in the second half and as a result was awarded 8 corner kicks to only one for the visitors. Shipon and his defenders bent but did not break. Particularly strong on defense were seniors Jon Robinson and Andy Cino. Abington's freshman forward duo of Chris Hood and Stewart Rodes were continually dangerous, but unable to put the ball past Shipon. Between the 66<sup>th</sup> and 76<sup>th</sup> minutes Abington had 2 directs (including one which had to be tipped over the bar) and four corner kicks. Shipon had 12 saves and Arnold had 8.

George, the first fourth place finisher in the regular season to win a title, knocked off first place Moorestown on penalty kicks in a semifinal match at Moorestown on Saturday, October 30<sup>th</sup>. The Foxes opened the scoring in the 22<sup>nd</sup> minute on an unassisted goal by senior Jackiem Wright. The visitors tied it up in the 69<sup>th</sup> minute on a goal by Nishimoto assisted by senior Nico Houghton. There was no further scoring through regulation play and 30 minutes of overtime, thus forcing a shootout for the third consecutive year. George converted on each of their first four shots, while Moorestown missed one and had their fourth shot saved at the post by a diving Shipon.

Abington reached the championship game with a 3-2 homefield semifinal win over ANC also on the 30<sup>th</sup>. The 'roos opened the scoring in the 5<sup>th</sup> minute when senior Liam Gallagher headed in a long throw by junior Seth Taft. The Lions responded quickly with a 7<sup>th</sup> minute header by senior Anders Hyatt off the rebound of a shot by junior Joseph Herr. Rodes headed in another Taft throw just four minutes later to put the hosts back on top. Rodes scored again on a solo effort in the 50<sup>th</sup> minute and Herr brought the Lions back to within one with a 55<sup>th</sup> minute goal off an assist from junior Kian Holmes.

## SHIPON AND APPLETON LEAD THE ALL LEAGUE TEAM

George School junior goalkeeper Seth Shipon was named by the Friends Schools League coaches to the Pennsylvania all-state team and was joined by Moorestown senior Jerry Appleton on the all-Southeastern PA team. The complete all-league and honorable mention teams are as follows. The all-league team will play in an all-star game on Friday, November 26<sup>th</sup>.
