ABINGTON OPENS LEAGUE SEASON WITH A WIN

Visiting Abington Friends opened the 1987 FSL season with a 3-1 win over Friends Select on Friday, September 18. The Kangaroos opened the scoring two minutes into the first half as junior Howard Rosen flicked a throw-in to senior Dan Feldgus who scored from 14 yards out. The score remained 1-0 for the next hour of play. In the 62nd minute Feldgus passed to senior Matt Perry who scored from the middle, 12 yards out. Thirteen minutes later Select got on the board as junior Francis Rizzo knocked in the rebound of a hard shot by senior Tarik Haydar. Abington closed out the scoring in the 78th minute as Rosen connected after a scuffle in front of the goal. Senior Dan Seitchick was credited with the assist. Abington is 1-0 in the league and 2-2 overall. Select is 0-1 and 0-2.

WESTTOWN AND MOORESTOWN TIE 2-2

Moorestown came back twice to tie host Westtown in the league opener for both teams on Saturday, September 19. After a scoreless first half which saw end-to-end action with Westtown having more chances, the hosts opened the scoring about five minutes into the second half. Junior Bill Romberger got the goal with junior Jamie Hinkley credited with the assist. Moorestown evened the score within ten minutes as senior Lance Johnson netted a goal with the assist going to senior Ricky Kanefsky. Regulation time ended with the score still 1-1. Westtown scored within five minutes of the first overtime as junior Dan Fischer hit a ball from the corner of the penalty area over the keeper's head. Two minutes later Johnson retied the score with a flick-on header past the onrushing keeper. Junior Michael Schnyder took the kick and got the assist for Moorestown. The game was the first of the season for both teams.

GERMANTOWN BLANKS CENTRAL

Visiting Germantown Friends built a 2-0 halftime lead on the way to a 3-0 victory over Friends' Central on Friday, September 25. The Tigers opened the scoring in the 20th minute as senior Paul Coviello unloaded a 25 yard shot from straight on. Junior Josh Sears made the through pass for the assist. Six minutes later senior David Felsen received a throw-in deep in the penalty box. His first shot was smothered by the defense but he retrieved the rebound and scored from about six yards out. In the 56th minute Coviello sent a through ball right up the middle pairing Felsen and a defender one-on-one. Felsen won the ball and ripped a shot from just inside the penalty box to close out the scoring. Senior David Weiss and junior Topher Kerr shared the shutout for the winners. Germantown is 1-0 in the league and 2-4-1 overall. Friends' Central is 0-1 in FSL play and 1-4 overall.

GEORGE_OPENS_WITH_A_SHUTOUT

Visiting George School posted two first-half goals to beat Moorestown 2-0 on Saturday, September 26. In the 8th minute sophomore D.J. Johnson threw the ball in over the defense where senior Matt Parker scored a first time shot from only seven yards out. In the 25th minute senior Pete Eschallier took control of the ball at the corner of the penalty box and chipped in an unassisted left-footed goal from about 15 yards out. Other opportunities for both teams yielded nothing as senior Alex Briscoe notched the shutout for the Cougars. Senior David Wunner was assigned the difficult task of marking Moorestown's Lance Johnson man-to-man and in doing so contributed significantly to the shutout. George School is 1-0 in the league and 1-1-1 overall. Moorestown is 0-1-1 in FSL play and 1-2-1 overall.

MOORESTOWN TIES ABINGTON

Visiting Moorestown scored on a penalty kick late in the first half to gain a 1-1 tie with Abington on Tuesday, September 29. Abington opened the scoring in the 32nd minute as senior Matt Perry netted a goal with the assist going to senior Gary Charnis. Six minutes later the hosts were whistled for a hand ball in the area and senior Lance Johnson scored from the penalty stripe. Neither team was able to score during the remaining hour of regulation and overtime. Abington moves to 1-0-1 in the league and 2-3-2 overall. Moorestown is now 0-1-2 in FSL play and 1-2-2 overall.

GERMANTOWN BLANKS WESTTOWN 2-0

Visiting Germantown scored one goal in each half and held Westtown scoreless on Thursday, October 1. Senior Paul Coviello opened the scoring in the ninth minute with a fifteen yard shot after a pass from junior Josh Sears. In the 64th minute Coviello's corner kick rebounded to senior Ben Scirica who first-timed it past the keeper from 12 yards out. Senior David Weiss was in goal for the Tigers who played with a strong wind at their backs during the first half and maintained pressure on the hosts as the wind died down in the second half. Germantown is 2-0 in the league and 3-5-1 overall. Westtown falls to 0-1-1 in FSL play and 0-3-1 overall.

GEORGE HOLDS ON FOR 1-0 WIN

Host George School scored at 34:30 and then held off hard-charging Friends' Central for a 1-0 win on Thursday, October 1. George was having the better of the play in the first half when senior Matt Parker took the ball away from a fullback and slipped a through pass to senior Chris Rivinus who beat the keeper one-on-one. The second half saw the visiting Phoenix come to life and only a superb save by George goalie senior Alex Briscoe on junior Kirk Meloney with about three minutes remaining prevented the game from going into overtime. George is now 2-0 in the league and 3-1-1 overall. Central fell to 0-2 in FSL play and 1-7-0 overall.

FRIENDS' CENTRAL TOPS MOORESTOWN

Visiting Friends' Central won their first FSL game of the year as they beat Moorestown 2-1 on Tuesday, October 6. Moorestown opened the scoring on an unassisted goal by senior Lance Johnson about 10 minutes into the play. Soon after that, Friends' Central was awarded a penalty kick which Moorestown keeper David Caparelli saved. In the 32nd minute, though, Phoenix junior Scott Erlbaum netted a left-footer from about 25 yards out at the corner of the box. Junior Jay Willson got the assist. Erlbaum tallied again about midway through the second half from 12 yards out, assisted this time by junior Kyle Richter. Friends' Central also knocked three balls off the posts in the second half. The Phoenix rise to 1-2-0 in the league and 2-7-0 overall while Moorestown drops to 0-2-2 in FSL play and 2-3-2 overall.

WESTTOWN WINS FIRST

Visiting Westtown shut out Friends Select 3-0 on Tuesday, October 6 to gain its first win of the season. After a scoreless first half, the hosts were whistled for a push in the area early in the second half and Westtown junior Dan Fischer scored on the penalty kick. That opened the door for the visitors who got their second goal soon after from the foot of sophomore Charlie Coltman. Senior Matt Chamberlin closed out the scoring with a goal late in the contest. Westtown upped its league mark to 1-1-1 and its overall record to 1-6-1. Select fell to 0-2-0 and 0-6-0.

GEORGE WINS IN FINAL 30 SECONDS

Visiting George School came back from a 3-1 halftime deficit and beat Abington 4-3 with a last minute goal on Friday, October 9. Abington opened the scoring in the eighth minute on a penalty kick taken by senior Greg Bowie. In the 26th minute Bowie fed senior Dan Feldgus for a 2-0 lead. George tallied in the 38th minute on a goal by sophomore Steve Jo with an assist to junior M.J. Berman. Abington was not finished for the half, though, as Feldgus fed senior Matt Perry at the 39:30 mark to put the 'roos up 3-1. George began its comeback in the 42nd minute as Berman lofted a long cross/shot over the keeper to pull the Cougars to within one. In the 63rd minute senior Matt Parker tied the score on an unassisted goal after a scramble in front of the Abington net. Then, with everyone's thoughts on overtime, Parker scored again with just 30 seconds remaining after the Abington defense failed to clear the ball from in front of their goal. George upped its record to 3-0-0 in the league and 4-1-2 overall. Abington fell to 1-1-1 in FSL play and 3-4-2 overall.

GERMANTOWN REMAINS UNBEATEN

On Tuesday, October 13 Germantown travelled to Fairmount Park and returned with a 2-0 win over host Friends Select. In a game which was played for much of the time in front of the Select goal, the Tigers forced an own-goal in the fourth minute. A long punt by senior goalie David Weiss was hotly pursued by the GFS forward line and a hurried back pass by the Falcon defense eluded their keeper. Weiss was credited with the goal. Fifteen minutes later senior David Felsen scored from in close with the assist going to senior Paul Coviello. Although there was continued pressure, there was no more scoring due in great part to the efforts of Select keeper Step Nagy. Weiss and junior Topher Kerr shared the shutout for the visitors who have yet to allow a league goal. Germantown is now 3-0-0 in FSL play and 5-6-1 overall. Select is 0-3-0 the league and 0-7-0 overall.

ABINGTON EDGES CENTRAL

In the 73rd minute a Select trip in the area resulted in a penalty kick which Johnson scored for his 4th FSL goal of the year. GERMANTOWN CLINCHES FIRST PLACE

In a very exciting, back-and-forth game, host Germantown Friends beat George School 3-2 on Tuesday, October 27. GEORGE SCHOOL REPEATS AS CHAMPIONS

George School used a stifling defense and an opportunistic offense to win its second consecutive FSL soccer championship on Sunday, November 15 by a 3-0 score over host Germantown Friends. The game, which was twice postponed by weather, was played before a large crowd under beautiful conditions. George opened the scoring on a lovely goal at 19:42 as senior Matt Parker made a weak-side run from the right side and headed in a lofted direct kick from junior fullback M.J. Berman. Germantown, which had a number of scoring opportunities through the early going, continued to knock at the door after George scored, but was continually denied. One particular example came early in the second half when senior Tiger sweeper Eric Williams targeted a header off a corner kick for the near post, past the keeper only to be saved by a fullback on the line. The score remained 1-0 until the 65:30 mark when senior right wing Pete Eschallier scored from the right side after an assist from Parker on a counter-attack. Sophomore Steve Jo closed out the scoring at the 77:00 minute mark with a long high ball into the far corner from the right side. Senior M.J. Goldberg got the assist. Senior Alex Briscoe notched the shutout for the Cougars with great help from his defensive corps. Germantown had many more scoring opportunities than George, but was unable to convert any of them.

George is the first team in league history to win back-to back soccer championships and the only team to win while not placing first during the regular season. The game was marked by spirited clean play by both teams and the respect and admiration the teams had for each other was evident during the emotional post-game handshakes. George ended the season with a 10-3-2 mark overall and 7-1-0 in the league. Germantown had the same league record and was 10-7-2 overall.

In the semifinal games on Friday, November 6 Germantown beat Abington 3-1 and George blanked Westtown 1-0. Germantown scored first on a low corner kick by senior Paul Coviello which senior David Felsen knocked in at the near post at the 9:30 mark. Just 42 seconds later Coviello scored one on one with the keeper after a fine through ball by senior David Buffum. At 18:40 Abington senior Greg Bowie scored on a penalty kick awarded for a push in the area. After that Abington was right in the game and continued to challenge until the deciding goal came at the 65 minute mark. Senior David DuTot took a throw in and led Felsen perfectly up the middle of the field yielding a one on one with the keeper which Felsen converted for his ninth FSL goal of the season. Senior David Weiss and junior Topher Kerr shared the goaltending for the Tigers.

In the other semifinal contest George used a wind-aided goal early in the second half to defeat Westtown 1-0. After a scoreless first half, sophomore

O.J. Johnson put a ball up into the wind which eluded the Westtown fullback and which senior M.J. Goldberg knocked in at 45:45. After that, play was fairly even as both teams had some good chances. Most of Westtown's chances, however, were smothered in the defense thus giving senior keeper Alex Briscoe a nervous, if not spectacular shutout. It was his second in a week against Westtown.

JOHNSON AND RIVINUS LEAD ALL-LEAGUE SELECTIONS

Senior midfielder Lance Johnson from Moorestown was named the top player in the league by the coaches and was joined by senior striker Chris Rivinus from George School as the Friends Schools League representatives on the all Southeast PA team. Johnson, who scored 21 goals overall (6 in the league), will receive all-state recognition. Johnson and Rivinus were joined by 12 other all-league honorees and another 12 players were recognized with honorable mention status. These players will play for the Friends Schools League in the Easter Seals Charity All-Star game on Friday, November 27 against a team from the Del-Val League. The game will be played at 9:00 AM at Haverford College. The All-League selections are as follows:
