BOARDING SCHOOLS UNBEATEN IN EARLY SEASON LEAGUE PLAY

Westtown opened the 1990 FSL soccer season with a 2-1 road win over Germantown on Friday, September 14. Senior James Carmona opened the scoring for the visitors in the 30th minute. His goal followed one which had been disallowed for offsidess. The 1-0 score held through halftime. Seven minutes into the second half Westtown junior Alan Henderson took a ball from freshman Charlie Buterbaugh and made a solo breakaway from midfield, eventually scoring into the far corner from about 18 yards out. Germantown answered with a goal seven minutes later on a 40 yard shot from the right side by junior Peter Spaeth which dipped under the crossbar but over the keeper into the far corner. Junior Joel Zuercher had the assist. Both sides had some good chances after that, but there were no other goals.

On Friday, September 21 host Germantown defeated defending FSL champion Friends' Central 4-1. Opening the scoring after only 67 seconds was freshman Zevi Tilles who headed in a strong cross from junior Joel Zuercher. The same twosome repeated their efforts for a second goal five minutes later. Seven minutes before the half senior Steve Malmed put the Tigers up 3-0 on a solo effort. The Phoenix got on the scoreboard in the 52nd minute when senior Atfi Ahmad scored from sophomore David Lakoff's corner kick. GFS answered with a final goal three minutes later when Zuercher's throw in was kicked into the Phoenix goal by their own defense.

On Saturday, September 22 Moorestown travelled to George School and managed a 0-0 tie through the first half due mainly to the excellent play of senior keeper, David Barbour. In the second half, though, the host Cougars put home three goals before Moorestown could notch one. Senior Tony Guerrero opened the scoring for the hosts on a penalty kick in the 47th minute. Seven minutes later junior Dan Secrest crossed a ball which Barbour was able to tip but senior Bob Benck knocked home the free ball. After seven more minutes Benck scored again, this time from the penalty spot on a cross from junior Dave Restituto. Moorestown broke through in the 63rd minute when senior Donald Orth headed in a ball from senior Jon Yohannon.

Moorestown hosted Abington on Tuesday, September 25 and handed the visitors a 5-0 defeat. Senior Tony Yi scored unassisted goals in the 3rd and 35th minutes. In between senior Fred Peguero netted a goal in the 15th minute on an assist from junior Shane McAleer. Peguero scored again on a breakaway in the 42nd minute and senior Raj Guharoy closed out the scoring in the 75th minute with McAleer again assisting. Senior David Barbour notched the shutout.

George School gained its second league win with a 4-0 road triumph over Friends' Central on Wednesday, September 26. All four goals came in the first half with sophomore Tom Helmcamp opening the scoring on a free kick from 40 yards out in the fourth minute. Senior Bob Benck tallied his third league goal in the 14th minute with the assist going to sophomore Isaac Gowin. Senior Joe Davidyock scored an unassisted goal in the 20th minute and junior Dave Restituto closed out the scoring in the 30th minute with the assist going to junior Ake Chijioko. Friends' Central stiffened its defense in the second half and shut down the potent Cougar attack. Senior Ben Smith and sophomore Matt Milewski shared the shutout for the visitors.

RECORD GOAL SCORING SPREES MARK RECENT GAMES

Two juniors put their names in the FSL record book with remarkable individual games during the past two weeks. Westtown's Alan Henderson netted all five goals in a 5-2 win over Moorestown on October 5th and Germantown's Joel Zuercher scored four goals in a 7-2 win over Abington on October 12th. Henderson added a two goal - two assist game earlier in the week to give him a staggering nine points in two games. Previously the high for individual goal scoring in a league game was three held by at least six different players. Both Henderson and Zuercher are looking at a league season scoring record of 13 goals by Takyi Morgan of GFS in 1983. David Felsen of GFS had nine goals and three assists in league play in 1987 and Marc Ferry of Abington had eight league goals in 1984. Nine league games were played during the past two weeks and the results were as follows.

On Tuesday, October 2 visiting Moorestown scored once in each half to beat Friends' Central 2-1. The visitors scored in the first minute on a goal by senior Fred Peguero with the assist going to senior Raj Guharoy. In the 47th minute senior Tony Yi pushed the score to 2-0 netting a goal after a huge punt from senior keeper David Barbour who got the assist. Nine minutes later Friends' Central sophomore David Fenkel scored on a penalty kick. Play was fairly even for the remainder of the game, but neither team was able to score.

Also on October 2 host George School shut out visiting Abington 5-0. The Cougars tallied twice in the first half and three more times in the second stanza. In the 20th minute junior Tim Gronert scored off a loose ball. Four minutes later senior Bob Benck scored from a Gronert assist. Four minutes into the second half junior Bob Machemer netted a penalty kick. Another four minutes into the half Machemer tallied a second unassisted goal. Junior Jason Bae closed out the scoring with an unassisted goal at the 64 minute mark. Senior Ben Smith and sophomore Matt Milewski shared the shutout.

On the same day host Westtown topped Friends Select 5-0. Alan Henderson warmed up for his record setting performance later in the week with a fine two goal - two assist performance against the Falcons. Other goal scorers for the hosts were seniors James Carmona and Daron Barnard and junior Jay Zelmuth. Senior Nathan Slack added an assist, while seniors Craig Fields and Josh Robbins shared the shutout in goal.

On Friday, October 5 Moorestown travelled to Westtown and ran into Henderson's "career" game. The junior had three first half goals which more than cushioned a Westtown own goal off a throw-in by Moorestown junior Shane McAleer. The visitors closed to 3-2 on a successful 55th minute penalty kick by senior Fred Peguero. After that, though Henderson resumed his efforts and produced the final two goals in what was by all accounts a closer match than the final score would seem to indicate. Assists for Westtown went to freshman Charlie Buterbaugh and seniors Chris Kaiser and Nathan Slack. The best back-to-back effort previously in the league occurred in 1983 when Takyi Morgan of GFS had consecutive hat-tricks.

On Tuesday, October 9 Abington hosted Friends' Central and the visitors took their first win of the year by a 1-0 score. Sophomore David Fenkel netted a penalty kick in the 8th minute of play, after which play was pretty much even. Phoenix sophomore keeper Kevin Dyer saved a second half penalty kick on the way to the shutout.

On Wednesday, October 9 Germantown hosted Friends Select and handed the visitors a 3-2 defeat. Freshman Zevi Tilles opened the scoring for the Tigers in the fourth minute of play. Senior Steve Malmed passed the ball for the assist. The hosts took a 2-0 halftime lead as junior Joel Zuercher netted an unassisted goal in the 35th minute. Select senior Josh Mandel took advantage of a defensive turnover and put the Falcons on the board in the 54th minute. Tilles wasted little time regaining the two goal lead with his second score in the 56th minute with the assist going to junior A.J. Cochino. Falcon sophomore Colin Convey closed out the scoring in the 63rd minute with a nice solo effort.

On Friday, October 12 Friends Select notched its first league win with a 1-0 decision at Moorestown. After a scoreless first half, the Falcons tallied midway through the second period as senior Aaron Matzkin converted on a chip from senior Alex Swift. Sophomore Eric Siskin held off the Moorestown attack for the shutout.

Also on October 12, junior Joel Zuercher led Germantown to a 7-2 road win over Abington. Zuercher netted a career high four goals. He opened the scoring in the second minute with the assist going to freshman Zevi Tilles on a back pass. Zuercher had an unassisted goal in the seventh minute. Senior Steve Malmed scored in the 22nd minute with the assist going to junior Andrew Goldberg. Abington junior Jess Balcar scored on a crisp header off a corner kick in the 33rd minute. In the second half, as the rain came down more steadily, Zuercher tallied twice more, once assisted by junior Steve Dutot. Senior Neil Toensmeier converted a penalty kick and Tilles closed out the scoring for the Tigers with an assist going again to Goldberg. The 'roos final goal was scored by sophomore Tshaka Tsolo with an assist from Balcar.

On Saturday, October 13 Friends' Central played perhaps its best soccer of the year before an appreciative homecoming crowd, but fell 1-0 to Westtown. The visitors scored in the middle of the second half on a direct kick taken by senior Chris Kaiser from just outside the area. The Phoenix had some good chances but were thwarted by the Westtown defense anchored by senior keeper Craig Fields.

GEORGE SCHOOL CLINCHES FIRST, PLAYOFF POSITIONS SET

George School clinched first place with three shutouts over the last two weeks to complete a perfect 6-0 regular season. On Tuesday, October 16 the Cougars travelled to Fairmount Park and beat the defense-minded Falcons of Friends Select 1-0 on a goal scored by the Falcons with only two minutes left to play. Senior Ben Smith and sophomore Matt Milewski shared the shutout. On Saturday, October 20 George went to Westtown and came home with another 1-0 win, their first at Westtown since 1969. Junior Dave Restituto headed in a chip from junior Bob Machemer in the 48th minute. The Cougars

early scored again on another head ball about three minutes later. Westtown, which was missing a number of regulars due to injury, came on fairly strong towards the end of the contest, but could not put the ball past Smith in the goal. On Wednesday, October 24 George continued their shutout streak with a 4-0 win over Germantown. Senior Joe Davidyock opened the scoring with a goal in the sixth minute after a takeaway from the defense. The Tigers stiffened and the remainder of the half was an even contest. In the second half, though, George struck for three goals in an 11 minute span early in the stanza. In the 43rd minute Davidyock headed in a direct kick taken from the endline just outside the area by junior Jason Bae. In the 47th minute senior Bob Benck scored an unassisted goal and then Bae finished the scoring in the 54th minute when his well struck corner kick glanced in off a Tiger defender. Smith and Milewski again shared the shutout.

The Tigers secured their playoff spot with a 3-2 win over host Moorestown on Monday, October 22. The visitors were generous early, making an errant back pass to keeper which was intercepted and scored by Moorestown senior Fred Peguero in the third minute of play. Germantown freshman Zevi Tilles then took over, scoring a natural hat trick before the half was over. Tilles was in the right place at the right time three times, pushing in goals from close range at the far post each time. Assists went to juniors Steve DuTot and Joel Zuercher and sophomore Sam Wyatt. Moorestown closed the gap on a fine 25 yard shot by junior Shane McAleer with about 10 minutes left to play but the Tigers held on for the win.

Friends Select gained a playoff berth for the first time since 1986 with a 3-1 win over visiting Friends' Central on Friday, October 19. Select opened quickly with a second minute goal by senior Josh Mandel with senior Aaron Matzkin giving the assist. The Phoenix knotted the score before halftime on a goal by sophomore David Lakoff with an assist coming from senior Atif Ahmad. The Falcons took over in the second half when Matzkin tallied twice, assisted once by sophomore Colin Convey. Select closed out the regular season with a 3-2 win over host Abington on Friday, October 26. Convey opened the scoring with an early first-half penalty kick for the Falcons. Matzkin then took over again for the visitors with two first half goals, the first of which was assisted by junior Steve Caplan. The 'roos closed the first half scoring with a penalty kick by senior Matt Davis. Junior Jesse Balcer netted an early second half goal for the hosts, but Select hung on for their third league win.

Westtown gained a rain-delayed 3-0 win over Abington on Wednesday, October 24 which, along with Germantown's loss to George School, clinched second place for the hosts. Junior Alan Henderson, the league's leading scorer, opened with an unassisted goal about five minutes into the game. Senior Chris Keiser and junior Ben D'Urbano added unassisted second half goals to close out the scoring. Senior Josh Robbins garnered the shutout.

Semifinal play on Friday, November 2 will see Select travel to George School and Germantown visit Westtown in 2:15 games. The winners will meet for the FSL championship on Tuesday, November 6. In regular season play George defeated Select 1-0 and Westtown topped Germantown 2-1.

GEORGE SCHOOL WINS THIRD CHAMPIONSHIP

George School capped an undefeated FSL season with a 2-0 win over visiting Westtown on Tuesday, November 6. Senior Bob Benck opened the scoring in the ninth minute of play when he received a floater from sophomore Isaac Gowen and nodded it past his defender to go one-on-one with the keeper whom he beat with a quick shot. The Cougars' second goal was an unassisted blast from 35 yards out by senior Jeff Dare. The score came three minutes before halftime. Westtown pressed the issue in the second half, but George's senior Keeper Ben Smith made several excellent saves to keep the visitors off the scoreboard. George has made it to the championship game for the past six years, winning previously in 1986 and 1987. This was the first time, though, that they had placed first in the regular season.

George School reached the championship game with a decisive 3-0 win over fourth place Friends Select. The Cougars put a cramp in the Falcons upset plans early with a goal off a corner kick in the second minute of play. Senior Joe Davidyock headed in the kick taken by junior Jason Bae. Junior Bob Machemer headed in a lofted ball from Gowen in the 36th minute and Bae closed out the scoring with an unassisted effort six minutes into the second half. Smith and sophomore Matt Milewski shared the shutout.

Westtown and Germantown locked up in the other semifinal and the result was one of the most entertaining, best played FSL games in recent memory. Westtown won 2-1 on a goal two minutes into the second overtime period. The game featured non-stop end-to-end action, packed with excellent scoring chances and spectacular defense by both teams. Particularly impressive was Tiger senior keeper Neil Toensmeier who turned away 25 shots, many of them in acrobatic fashion. His Westtown counterpart, senior Craig Fields, also had his hands full, making sixteen saves. Germantown opened the scoring in the tenth minute of play as junior sweeper A.J. Rocchino and a number of Westtown defenders went high for a throw in launched by junior Joel Zuercher. The ball deflected in off a defender with Rocchino receiving credit. Three minutes later sophomore Drew Kenworthy and senior Chris Keiser hooked up on a beautifully executed goal to even the score. The ball was crossed from left to right and Keiser angled the ball back into the left corner of the goal. Despite brilliant efforts by both teams, no one else could score through regulation or the first overtime. In the second minute of the the second OT, FSL scoring leader junior Alan Henderson blasted a left footer past a diving Toensmeier. The hosts' celebration was short-lived as the Tigers came storming back and put on intense pressure for the final eight minutes. And although the Westtown defense bent, it did not break.

ALL-LEAGUE TEAM NAMED, TWO PLAYERS GET HIGH HONORS

Senior Bob Benck a forward from George School was named by the FSL coaches as the top player in the league and therefore qualified for all-state honors. Benck was joined by Moorestown senior keeper David Barbour as the FSL representatives on the Southeastern PA all-area team. They will play in an all-star game at Villanova University on Sunday, November 25. The following players were named to the 1990 FSL all-league teams. The members of the first team will play as a unit against the all-league team from an as yet undetermined league at Haverford College on Friday, November 23 at a time to be announced.
